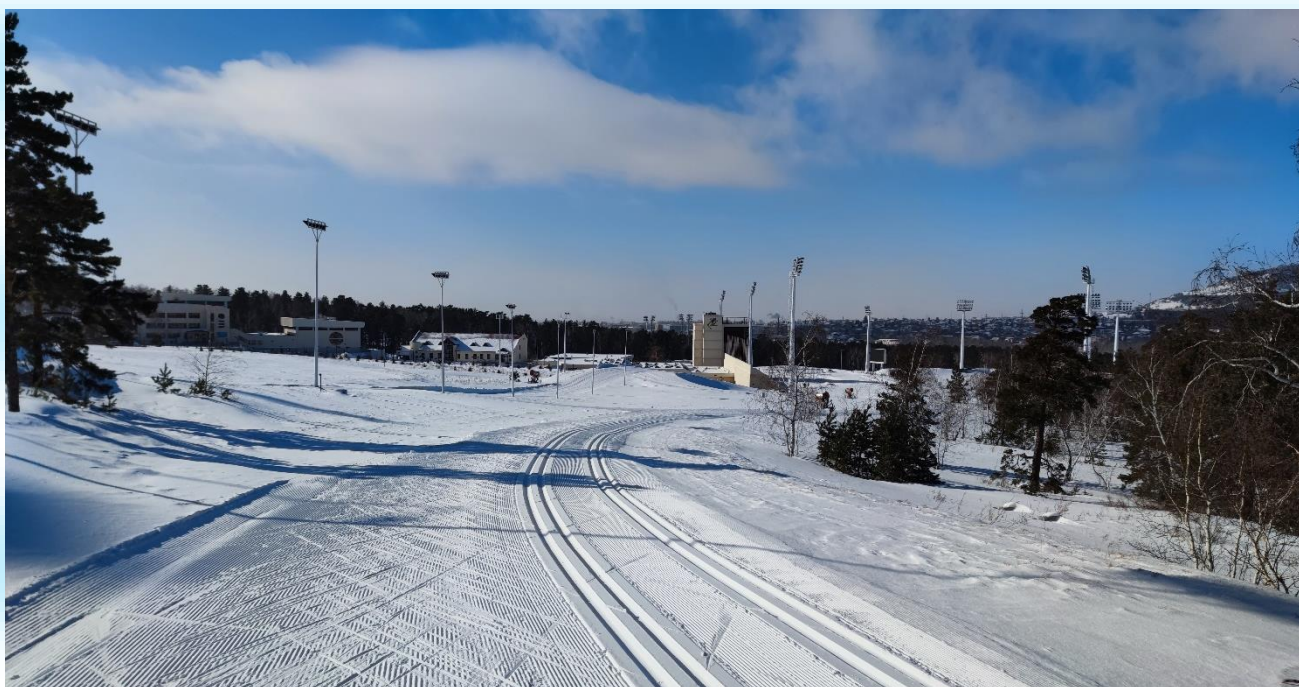

For the competitions, 1.4 km (sprint) and 5 km (distance races) courses will be used. Courses maps at [schuchinsk-eec.kz](https://schuchinsk-eec.kz). Courses may be changed by the jury's decision.



## ACCOMODATION

Official team accommodation is provided by the National Ski Center's sports hotel. Conveniently located on-site, this facility was opened in 2018 and is fully equipped for athletes, offering a capacity of 200 people.

Accommodation is available in double and quadruple rooms.

The rate ranges from 25000 to 35000 KZT and includes three meals a day, as well as full access to the sports facilities, including the 25-meter pool, gym, and sauna.

# TRANSPORT

The nearest international airports: Kokshetau (70 km), Astana (240 km), Petropavlovsk (270 km). Schuchinsk is located on highway A1 and railway line Astana-Kokshetau-Petropavlovsk (railway station "Kurort Borovoye"/Курорт Боровое).

# OTHER INFORMATION

Use of the course is free of charge during the competition (21.03-28.03).

On all other days, the daily rate is 3000 KZT per person.

Team rooms (includes a locker room for 20 people and a wax room) are available for rent at 5000 KZT per room per day.

# RULES

The FIS Eastern Europe Cup (EEC) serves as the Continental Cup for the region, which includes Kazakhstan. The series allows Kazakhstani athletes to secure additional World Cup quotas beyond the standard national limit.

While international athletes may participate under general FIS conditions, their results do not count toward the World Cup quota rankings.

A valid medical insurance policy is mandatory for participation.

Competitions are held in accordance with the [International FIS Rules](#) and the [FIS Continental Cup Rules](#). A FIS code is required for participation. The minimum age of participants is 2010 year of birth. **No entry fee.**

# INDIVIDUAL NEUTRAL ATHLETES (AIN)

Participation of athletes under the Individual Neutral Athlete (AIN) program is permitted. Athletes in this category who plan to compete must comply with all criteria specified in the AIN section of the [FIS website](#), including but not limited to:

- *Flags: When a flag is required for identification purposes, only the FIS flag may be used.*

- *Uniforms & Equipment: Uniforms, clothing, equipment, and accessories of AIN athletes and their support personnel must not reflect national colors or contain any references to Russia or Belarus.*
